The Ford EcoSport held off a strong challenge to remain at the top of the sales table for crossovers in October. Sales totalled 1 265 units, which was a big leap from the 561 units retailed in the same month last year. The recently-launched Volkswagen T-Cross put up another strong performance in this competitive category, selling 1 132 units.



The Suzuki Ertiga MPV not only scored a class win in the recent WesBank Fuel Economy Tour in partnership with FNB, but also performed strongly in terms of its sales in October, retailing 166 units, compared to only 65 in the same month a year previously. It is nevertheless still far behind the MPV market leader, the Toyota Avanza, which sold 615 units in October.
